Land of Lincoln Legal Assistance Foundation's Northern Regional Office seeks attorneys for three open positions. For more than 45 years, Land of Lincoln has provided cutting edge legal services and high quality representation to low income individuals and senior citizens in 65 counties in Illinois. Our open positions are described below:

Staff Attorney—SIU Medical Legal Partnership, Center for Family Medicine
This exciting and demanding attorney position requires the applicant to handle all facets of this Medical Legal Partnership including: providing civil legal services ranging from advice to representation to individuals referred by our health care partner; developing and presenting training programs to faculty doctors, nurses, residents and other healthcare professionals; create and present community legal education programs; supervise an intake specialist; and draft quarterly reports. This position is ideal for a self-starter and someone who can work independently.

Staff Attorney—Senior Legal Assistance Project
Attorneys passionate about meeting the critical civil legal needs of senior citizens are invited to apply. The position entails representing seniors in civil cases and transaction matters in a 12-county service area. The attorney will also collaborate with other senior service providers and community partners, travel to senior centers, and conduct community legal education and outreach.

Staff Attorney—Family Law Project
Attorneys eager to assist victims of domestic violence and their families as they seek safety through the judicial system should apply for this position. Work will entail representing victims in routine and complex family law litigation, including orders of protection, divorces, and custody cases. The attorney will collaborate with other community partners serving domestic violence victims to remove barriers that impact their ability to sever abusive relationships and access the court system.
